

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN and FINGERPRINTING

If you have not attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, please note that **this is a mandatory requirement for all parents and volunteers whose children attend Catholic schools.** The class is designed to provide factual information on sexual abuse while providing participants with an understanding of abuse that will motivate them to actively participate in prevention efforts. This important class explains the damage caused by sexual abuse and illustrates the need for adults to intervene on behalf of children.

Please remember that this class is mandatory for all parents and for all volunteers/staff who work with children in ANY CAPACITY. After attending the workshop, you will be required to complete 24 training bulletins through online registration or through the mail.

Parents and volunteers must also be fingerprinted and complete the Confidential Background Investigation Form (form available in the office). The Carson City Sheriff's Department offers fingerprinting to school volunteers at 911 E. Musser Street. The fee is \$16.00 per person.
