TUITION RATES

CATEGORY A: Families must attend mass weekly, be registered in St. Teresa of Avila Parish and share your time, talent and treasure. For the school year 2011-2012 families must have a previous 12 month history of contributions (January 2010 – December 2010) of at least \$500.00 to St. Teresa of Avila Parish and an annual gift of \$50.00 or more to CSA. Periodic, one-time or once a year donations will not be accepted in order to qualify for Category A.

CATEGORY B: All others who do not meet above criteria

TUITION PAYMENT OPTIONS:

- Full payment due in August
- Half due in August. Second half due in January.
- Ten monthly payments beginning in August and ending in May.

St. Teresa of Avila Catholic School uses FACTS Management to collect tuition for **all** families. Families who choose monthly payments will be assessed a \$43 enrollment fee by FACTS. All families are responsible for enrolling in FACTS Management. Tuition payments will be withdrawn on either the 5<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> of the month (parent's choice).

GAP DONATION

The total cost of educating a student at St. Teresa of Avila Catholic School is \$5,132.00 per student. The difference between the total cost per child and the assigned tuition rate is called GAP. This is the GAP between income and expenses that must be raised through donations and fundraisers.

For those with the financial ability to pay more than the assigned tuition rate, this GAP can be contributed as a tax-deductible donation. Contribution of all or a portion of this GAP is greatly appreciated.
